Mar 1 – Tomatoes (for very early tomatoes, planted into greenhouse mid-April)

Rosemary, Lavender

Mar. 9 Hab. Peppers

Mar. 21 Peppers (all other varieties)

Mar. 25 - Oregano/Mint

Tomatoes (for sale about Gold Show)

Celery

March 31 - Parsley/Thyme

Egg plant

Apr. 4 - Basil/Sage/Lemon Balm

Chives

Apr. 14 - Pacino Sunflowers (short)

#1 Brassicas (cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli, kohlrabi, kale, brussel sprouts, swiss chard)

#1 Lettuces (Romaine, leaf, head, buttercrunch)

Apr. 20 – Teddy Bear Sunflowers (medium height)

Melon/watermelon

Cucumbers

#2 Brassicas, Lettuces

Apr. 25 - Dill/ Cilantro

Ring of Fire Sunflowers (tall)

Zucchini/Pumpkin

Squash

#3 Brassicas/Lettuces

Weekly lettuces & brassicas to total 10 weeks for brassicas, 11 or 12 for lettuce
